The project ran successfully in 2022-23, with the Nineveh Charitable Trust's funding spent as planned. We are now working to secure funding to continue this work into 2023-24.

We underestimated some of the overhead costs (eg lighting, water), in particular due to recent increases in utility costs.

• How were any surplus funds used, or was further funding made available?

We were able to fund the extra from our earned income and reserves and have adjusted our budgeting for the future.

• Has the project been successful and well received by the beneficiaries?

The project reached its key targets: 41 young people took part (target was 40), with 200 sessions delivered. We updated our Monitoring and Evaluation during the year, and project participants reported improved health and wellbeing, increased social skills and confidence, and having gained experience in a working farm environment.

We feel that the project met with considerable success this year, especially as we were able to run fully for the whole year, compared with lockdown closures in the previous year. The project was oversubscribed, with a waiting list operating.
