Forest School is an ongoing project. My short-term aims have absolutely been fulfilled by the grant – I successfully spent all the money on new kit for Forest School. We have got a new canopy installed, giving us more dry space, which has enabled us to get a workbench out of the garage and in use. The grant also paid for sensory swings, hammock suspension systems, cast iron cookware, flasks for hot chocolate, wool carders and crafting odds and ends for use during Forest School sessions. I have been able to expand the Forest School area and activities available, something we would not otherwise have been able to afford.
