- Has the project we helped to fund been completed? If so, how is it maintained?
- We received £4,000 towards funding a part-time Volunteer and Schools Engagement (VaSE) Coordinator for six months, starting in August 2023 and ending in January 2024. Over the last six months, the VaSE Coordinator has worked directly with hundreds of young people from across the UK, providing knowledge of the unique opportunity of a long-term international volunteering placement with Project Trust. Therefore, the projects aim of increasing our recruitment of Volunteers and expanding Project Trust's educational reach across the UK has been achieved. We have secured further funding to maintain this project and fund a part-time VaSE Coordinator for a further six months.

- The funds contributed 59% towards the VaSE Coordinator's salary for a six-month period. This generous contribution meant that Project Trust only needed to source the remaining £2,762 plus on costs, which we did successfully.

- Has the project been successful and well received by the beneficiaries? Are you satisfied with the outcome, or, with hindsight, would some modifications have been appropriate?
- As a result of this project, we have seen an increase in the number of young people signing up to complete a long-term international volunteering placement with Project Trust offer. During this sixmonth period, the part-time VaSE Coordinator has attended 35 school talks, careers fairs across the UK, empowering hundreds of young people with the desire, motivation, and aptitude to realise their full potential. Following the 30 applicants we received from these events, 11 of these young people are actively fundraising for their international placement and one is currently teaching Environmental Science in the Philippines. We are very satisfied with the outcome of this project.
- Was funding for this project made available from any other sources?
- Yes. Funding for the remaining £2,762 plus on costs were sourced from an unrestricted grant we received during the previous financial year.
