Funding was applied from the Nineveh charitable Trust to complete a compost toilet and handwashing facilities to allow children to access the farm and ensure they have a safe and comfortable experience in a unique learning environment.

Work Completed

Work has been completed on handwashing facilities that included connecting to the mains water supply,

<u>Impact</u>

We have begun working with children and this included a residential trip for over 40 children in August 2023 that involved bushcraft and time spent experiencing rural life. These children came from the areas of Ashington and Newbiggin in Southeast Northumberland and are exploring how we can work together with other partners in getting more children onto farms and into rural areas by developing a specific program.
