Outfit Moray is an award-winning charity and social enterprise delivering outdoor learning, adventure, and nature exploration programmes that transform lives.

Founded in 2003, as a project in the Elgin Youth Development Group, and becoming a charity in 2006, this year we have had over 15,000 attendees across Moray; building confidence, self-esteem, and resilience, providing positive role models, and encouraging the acquisition of life skills and new experiences, through challenge and positive risk-taking.

We are a visionary, ambitious and passionate organisation, committed to making a difference in the lives of others and particularly those who are vulnerable and disadvantaged. Our unique approach to learning, education, training, and development applies to all that we do, whether working one-to-one with children referred to us, running holiday and respite weeks for vulnerable children, outdoor learning and adventure programmes with schools, or activity sessions to improve health and well-being in adults.


Our Values

Outfit Moray Strands



EnerG is Outfit Moray's main strand of programmes and focuses on providing outdoor learning and adventure activities for vulnerable and disadvantaged young people.



Activ8 is Outfit Moray's second strand after EnerG. It is focused on providing affordable and accessible outdoor learning and adventure for all the young people in Moray and their families. This is usually through local schools, holiday programmes, after school activities and transition events for Moray primary schools.



Innov8 is Outfit Moray's staff and volunteer training strand. We provide our staff and volunteers with the most up-to-date training which they are then able to use for the benefit of the local community.



Gener8 strand is about securing Outfit Moray's future for the next generation. By using our skills and training, we can provide support to the local community, such as first aid event cover and first aid training. These funds are reinvested into Outfit Moray's programme of events for vulnerable and disadvantaged young people.



Communic8 is Outfit Moray's teaching strand and gives them the opportunity to pass on their knowledge and information to the local community, whether that's through Bike Revolution bike maintenance classes or talks to local groups and clubs.

Our Projects



BIKE REVOLUTION (DELIVERY)

Making cycling more accessible for communities in Moray. Through this programme we offer a variety of projects such as Bikeability, Bike Doctor, Cycling Skills, Adaptive Cycling and Learn to Cycle.



FIRST AID TRAINING AND EVENT COVER

Outfit Moray offers a wide range of first aid training courses as well as first aid event cover for adventure challenges throughout the local area.



We offer a range of outdoor adventure activities and services for all ages.

We have a strong focus on supporting vulnerable and disadvantaged young people aged 8-18 and we do this through working with a variety of partners throughout Moray and surrounding areas. We also offer Adventure for All and Adult Adventure Days



BIKE REVOLUTION (ENTERPRISE)

Making cycling more affordable through bike sales, hire and classes. Our experienced team offer advice and guidance, maintenance classes, servicing and repairs as well as very popular bike hire and sales service.

What we did with your funding

The Nineveh Charitable Trust award supported our Outdoor Learning programme within our EnerG strand. These programmes provide outdoor learning and adventure activities for vulnerable and disadvantaged young people.

Your funding enabled us to run 12 fully funded EnerG sessions for nine local schools. These schools had reached out to us due to the significant needs faced by their pupils. Each session focuses on supporting the young people to develop confidence, self-esteem and improve physical and mental wellbeing.

92 young people attended these sessions and the activities included; archery and bushcraft, canoeing, mountain biking, climbing, paddle boarding and crate climbing.



The difference your funding made

For all our programmes, we capture quantitative and qualitative data through participant feedback and staff observations.

Feedback was asked from the participants after each activity and the aggregated responses from the whole programme are detailed below:

Enjoyment of activities - 98%
Feeling up for the challenge - 95%
Feeling part of the group - 98%
Feeling listened to - 97%
Willingness to try activities again - 97
